Phoenix, AZ — The **Phoenix Monsoon** will open their 7-home game **National Premier Soccer League NPSL** 2012 season on Saturday, April 7th against **Fullerton Rangers**. The home opener game will be played at Tolleson Union High School (9419 W. Van Buren Street Tolleson, Arizona) at 4:00 P.M., kicking off the first season for the **NPSL** soccer team.

“Fans are going to see some players who were drafted by **Major League Soccer MLS**, in some cases have played with the **MLS** senior team, and guys who play at major colleges,” Quintero said. “It’s a great challenge for us and a great opportunity for fans to see very good soccer in their own community.”
