At that time, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud in City Hall. Bidders are invited, but not required, to be present at the bid opening.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Installation of Pump Motor VFD's for Booster Station No. 7, inclusive of all power, instrument and control wiring for this site, and Division 16 (Electrical) and Division 17 (Instrumentation) work; and a Bid Additive for a SCADA Radio System.

The successful Bidder will be determined on the basis of the lowest responsive and responsible Proposal. The City of Tolleson reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, to waive any informalities, or irregularities in the Proposals received, and to accept the Proposal which in its judgment best serves the interests of the City.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish two (2) bonds. One (1) bond, to become effective upon award of the Contract, shall be a Performance Bond in a sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price including any additions to the Contract. The Bond shall be effective throughout the construction period, including a one (1) year warranty period. The successful Bidder shall also furnish a Labor and Material Payment Bond, in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price, to become effective upon award.
