NOTICE REGARDING POTENTIAL CONFLICTS OF INTEREST RELATED TO THE CITY OF TOLLESON HOUSING REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Pursuant to the United States Government CDBG Program Conflict of Interest Regulations (24 C.F.R. §570.611), the City of Tolleson, as a participating jurisdiction in the CDBG Program, hereby provides public notice of the potential conflicts of interest raised by applications by individuals to the Tolleson Housing Rehabilitation Program.
