



Proclamation

Termination of Proclamations of Emergency

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, determined that the COVID-19 outbreak presents conditions in Arizona that justified his declaration of a State of Emergency based upon the outbreak's threat to human health and safety; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020 and June 18, 2020, the former Mayor of the City of Tolleson, Anna Tovar, authorized by City Code § 4-4-4, ARS § 26-307, and/or ARS § 26-311 proclaimed that a local emergency exists and, thereafter, declared a continuing emergency related to COVID-19, imposing all necessary regulations to preserve the peace and order of the City; and

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2022, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, issued proclamation "Termination of Emergency, COVID-19"; ending the state's COVID-19 Declaration of Emergency based on the State reaching thresholds established by the Arizona Department of Health Services that established the virus as no longer being widespread as it once was; and


WHEREAS, on March 30, 2022, the Chairman of the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors, ended their COVID-19 Emergency Declaration; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code § 4-4-4, ARS § 26-307, and/or ARS § 26-311, the Mayor is authorized to declare termination of Proclamation of Emergency.


