

ARIZONA VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION



IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

October 6, 2008 Deadline to Register to vote in the General Election
November 4, 2008 General Election

Registration requirements:

- A citizen of the United States.
- 18 Years of age or older preceding the next general election.
- A resident of the state 29 days preceding the next general election.
- Not been convicted of a felony or treason or civil rights have been restored.

Proof of Citizenship: If you have an Arizona driver's license and/or an Arizona non-operating Identification Card issued by MVD on or after October 1, 1996, write the number in box 13 on the front of the form. *No additional documents are needed.*

If you do not have a driver's or a non-operating ID dated 10/1/96 or later, you will need:

- A legible copy of a birth certificate that verifies citizenship and legal documentation if the name on the birth certificate is not the same as your current legal name, such as a marriage license (can be a photocopy) or
- A U.S. Passport or U.S. naturalization documents (write the number of the certificate of in box 20 of the form) or
- A BIA card number, tribal treaty card number or tribal enrollment number to place in box 16 of the form or
- A legible photocopy of a driver license on non-operating identification from another state in the U.S. if license indicates applicant has provided proof of citizenship, or
- A legible photocopy of a Tribal Certificate of Indian Blood or Tribal or BIA Affidavit of birth.

You need to re-register if you have:

- Changed your name.
- Moved to a new location.
- Changed your political party affiliation.

IDENTIFICATION AT THE POLLS IN ARIZONA

If you are a registered voter, you will need to show proof of identity at the polling place. Give your name and address to the election official and present a photo ID with your name and address or two different forms of ID that bear your name and address.

Acceptable forms of photo ID (one required):

- Valid Arizona driver license or non-operating ID
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal ID
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued ID

Acceptable forms of ID without a photo (must bear your name and address (two required):

- Utility bill of the elector that is dated within ninety days of the date of the election. A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
- Bank or credit union statement that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election
- Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
- Indian census card
- Property tax statement of the elector's residence
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Vehicle insurance card
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued ID
- Voter Registration Card / Recorder's Certification
- Any "Official Election Material" mailing bearing your name and address

You can vote by provisional ballot if: (you will be given a receipt to verify the status of your vote)

- Your name is not on registration list
- The name and address on the registration list is not the same as the name and address on ID
- You moved to a new precinct within the county
- You have changed your name
- You were issued an early ballot
- Your ID is not sufficient
