

**INVITATION TO BID
CITY OF TOLLESON**

Sealed bids for **Van Buren Street Storm Drain Phase 2** will be received by the City of Tolleson at the Tolleson City Hall, 9555 W. Van Buren Street, until **2:00 p.m., Thursday, September 30, 2010**. At that time and place, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders are invited, but not required, to be present at the bid opening.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

This project consists of underground storm drain; stormwater collection structures, retention basin; pavement removal and replacement; sidewalk, valley gutter, curb and gutter removals and replacements; adjustment of manhole covers, water valve box and covers; and replacement of traffic striping and pavement markings.

Work is generally located along Van Buren Street between 96th Avenue and 95th Avenue, along 95th Avenue between Van Buren Street and Polk Street, along Polk Street between 95th Avenue and 94th Avenue, and along the 96th Avenue alignment between Van Buren Street and Harrison Street as shown on the project plans and as called for in the contract documents. **The project is being constructed in two separate phases. This invitation to bid is for Phase 2 only. Phase 1, not included in this invitation to bid, is work already constructed and specified on plans between Station 86+70 and Station 94+62 of the 96th Avenue alignment.**

All paving, grading, and drainage improvements will be in accordance with the MAG Standard Specifications and Details and/or City of Phoenix Supplements to MAG, unless otherwise specified. All pavement marking and signing shall be in accordance with ADOT standard drawings.

Each bidder's proposal shall be made on the form furnished in the Contract Documents.

Contract Documents, with completed Bid Proposal, must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, together with a bid bond or certified check or cashier's check for ten percent (10%) of the total base bid,

The successful Bidder will be determined on the basis of the lowest responsive and responsible Proposal. The City of Tolleson reserves the right to reject any or all Proposals, to waive any informalities, or irregularities in the Proposals received, and to accept the Proposal which in its judgment best serves the interests of the City.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish two (2) bonds. One (1) bond, to become effective upon award of the Contract, shall be a Performance Bond in a sum of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price including any additions to the Contract. The Bond shall be effective throughout the construction period, including a one (1) year warranty period. The successful Bidder shall also furnish a Labor and Material Payment Bond, in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price, to become effective upon award.
