

Does Your Home Need Repairs?



City of Tolleson Housing Rehabilitation Program

Tolleson's Housing Rehabilitation Program provides home repairs for eligible homeowners in the City's Redevelopment Area. Assistance is provided as a grant if under \$25,000, or as a 0% interest forgivable loan* if repairs total \$25,000-\$80,000. Maximum investment is \$80,000.

Eligible Applicants

- Must own and live in a home within Tolleson's Redevelopment Area
- Must be current on mortgage payments and property taxes
- Must be willing to sign a forgivable loan* if assistance totals \$25,000 or more
- Total household income must not exceed current income limits (see below)

Current Income Limits (effective June 1, 2025)

Household Size	Income Limit for Household
1 person	\$62,850
2 person	\$71,800
3 person	\$80,800
4 person	\$89,750
5 person	\$96,950
6 person	\$104,150

Eligible Repairs include:

- AC/swamp cooler/heating replacement
- Roof repair/replacement
- Electrical repairs
- Accessibility modifications (ramps, grab bars, showers)
- Appliances (stove, fridge, washer, dryer)
- Plumbing repairs (water heaters, sewer lines, gas lines, etc.)
- Repairs to doors, windows, stairs
- Painting

***How Does the Forgivable Loan Work? Do I Need to Repay the City?**

- The loan is secured by a lien (a Deed of Trust and Promissory Note) on the property
- There is no monthly payment, and there is no interest (0%) charged on the loan
- **The loan is forgiven at a prorated annual rate and is 100% forgiven at end of loan term**
- You do not need to repay the City any money if you (or a qualifying heir) continue to own and live in the house for the length of the loan (3-8 years, depending on the amount of assistance)

How to Apply for Assistance

Homeowners requesting home repair assistance may contact Noël Schaus (602-702-2401) at the City of Tolleson to be placed on an interest list to apply for the program.

The application will require copies of the following documents:

Documents Required for Application

- Last two (2) consecutive months' pay stubs for employment
- Most recent signed Federal Income Tax return and W-2/1099 forms
- Most current Benefit Award Letters (Social Security, Disability, Pension, Retirement, Child Support, Alimony, TANF/other public assistance, Unemployment, Worker's Compensation)
- Bank statements (checking and savings) from the last 3 months
- Asset statements (401Ks, life insurance, retirement accounts, annuities, investments, etc.)
- Social Security cards for all household members; birth certificates for all children under age 18, and photo I.D. for all adults
- Most current mortgage statement and property tax statement
- List of all property addresses where household members are listed as Title Holders
